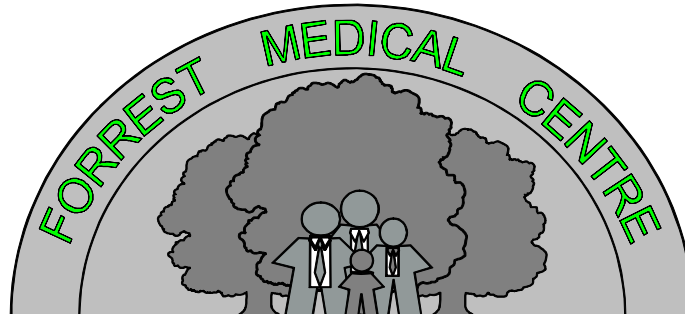

Repeat Prescriptions... Is there an easier way?

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

What is the easiest way to get my repeat prescription? There are basically 4 ways of doing this:

1. Phone the reception after 10.30am with your request (please ensure this is done after 10.30am to allow the phone lines to be free for those people wishing to book urgent appointments)
2. Drop off the counterfoil with the items you require clearly marked
3. Use the online repeat prescription request that is available on the Forrest Medical Centre website (www.fmcgp.co.uk) to submit your request and pick up your prescription from our Mount Street surgery
4. Use the online repeat pre-

scription request that is available on the Forrest Medical Centre website (www.fmcgp.co.uk) to submit your request and then simply pick up your medication from



your chosen chemist

Using option 4 your online prescription request will be sent on to your chosen chemist for them to collect (so that you just need to go to the chemist to collect your medications without coming into the surgery first to collect the prescription). They will then prepare the request and have it ready for you to collect within 48 hours.

All the information you need to complete this online form can be found on the paper Repeat Prescription form issued to you by your Doctor. Please be aware though that it is important that we receive a fully completed online form containing the correct data otherwise a Repeat Prescription cannot be issued. If there are any queries we will contact you either by phone or by email.

PLEASE NOTE: We can only accept Repeat Prescription requests for items listed on your paper Repeat Prescription form, unauthorised items cannot be dispensed. Please allow 24 hours for collection when using option 1 or 2 and 48 hours when using options 3 or 4.
